About the Course

This 2-day course will be instructed by **SafetyWorks!** of the Maine Department of Labor and hosted right at a boatyard. The course contains basic information about:

- Intro to OSHA
- Walking working surfaces (incl. scaffolding & possibly a section on cranes/hoisting equipment)
- Emergency Action Plan/Fire safety
- Electrical
- Flammable/Combustible liquids
- Personal Protective Equipment (incl. respirators)
- Machine Guarding
- Hazard Communication (incl. new GHS requirements)
- Intro to Industrial Hygiene incl. ergonomics and typical boatyard exposures to noise/styrene/wood dust
- Safety and Health Program – Supervisor Safety
- Powered Industrial Truck (forklifts)
- Lock-out/Tag-out.

Cost is **\$55.00** per person (MMTA Members) and includes lunch both days and the OSHA 10-hour general industry course completion card. \$70 per person for non-members.
